Training for the Michigan Concealed Pistol License

Tri-County Sportsman's League offers NRA "Personal Protection in the Home" courses that exceed the training requirements for a Michigan CPL. This is not a "Boot Camp" – the course goal is to develop in the students the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to the safe and efficient use of a handgun for protection of self and family, and to provide information on the law-abiding citizen's right to self-defense. We offer high quality instruction from an experienced staff of NRA instructors in a non-smoking, classroom environment. Learn to recognize the physiological and psychological changes that occur to your body in a life threatening situation and how to cope with them. Shoot with your "weak" hand, from behind cover, and practice point shooting (without sights). Shoot in a covered, outdoor pistol range. You will have the opportunity to train at, and perhaps join, one of the largest sportsman's clubs in the state of Michigan. You may choose to improve your defensive shooting skills at Tri-County Sportsman's League by participating in an International Defensive Pistol Association (IDPA) match. Several NRA Instructors who teach the Personal Protection classes also help run the IDPA matches at the club.
