AR-15 M16 Military Rifle Fun Match Saturday May 12, 2007

This is the first Military Rifle Match of the new season. The cost will be \$10. It will be on the 100 yd range. Sign in & orientation will be between 0830 & 0900 AM. Firing will begin at 1000. Match is open to all members & guests.

The rules are similar to last years rifle matches. Rifles allowed will be any AR/M16 type rifle in any configuration, (which means barrel lengths can vary as well as caliber). The rifle must have open iron sights. You must have two (2) magazines/clips capable of holding five (5) rounds each for the rapid fire stage. They can be 10 round or 20 round magazines. The match will consist of three (3) relays, & 35 rounds; you must supply your own ammo. Five rounds to sight in, 10 rounds each in three (3) positions. First position is prone slow fire, 10 rounds in 10 minutes, single round load. Next position is prone, 10 rounds rapid fire using two five round clips in 60 seconds. Last position is slow fire standing/ offhand. Ten rounds in 10 minutes loading one round at a time.

The sling may NOT be used in the standing/offhand position. We prefer slings be used in the prone positions, but not necessary. Help is available for those not familiar with the use of a sling. It is advisable to bring something to lie on in the prone position such as a shooting mat, blanket or exercise mat. You can bring a spotting scope if you wish. You can use a shooting coat if you have one.

Proposed Bylaw Changes

“ARTICLE 6” ADD SECTION 6A: YOUNG ADULTS:

A person who has attained the age of 18 years of age and is below the age of 23 will be assessed a fee of ½ of the Regular Membership dues.

“ARTICLE 5” ADD SECTION 8:

No officer or director shall receive any compensation whatsoever for their services as an officer or director. Officers and Directors shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the exercise of their duties and responsibilities.

“ARTICLE 5” ADD SECTION 9: Use of Revenue

All funds and assets of the club shall be used only for purposes consistent with the purposes of the club and for actual administrative expenses in conducting the affairs of the club under the direction and with the approval of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may purchase land, buildings and equipment and operate and maintain the same as required to further the purpose of the club.

ADD SECTION 10:

Use of Revenue for lawful purpose:
Revenues of the club shall not be used for the benefit of any individual, member or shareholder of the qualified organization except to further the lawful purposes of the club as stated in the Bylaws.
