Women-On-Target

Over 60 Tri-County members hosted 46 ladies for the First Annual Women-On-Target Instructional Shooting Clinic on Saturday, June 9th at the clubhouse and ranges. The purpose of the clinic was to introduce women to firearm safety and the shooting sports in an environment of fun and encouragement. The ladies fired nearly 10,000 rounds of ammunition as they rotated in groups to shoot rifles, pistols, large-caliber pistols, and shotguns. They also had the opportunity to try archery and a pin shoot. At least one-third of the ladies had never fired a gun before. They were treated to one-on-one coaching by experienced shooters from Tri-County at each station.

While the ladies had a great time at the event, no one anticipated the positive effect their contagious enthusiasm would have on the volunteers. As our coaches talked excitedly about the accomplishments of the ladies they helped, they actually shared the joy of success the lady shooters experienced. This event had more positive outcomes than anyone expected, and will surely be offered next year.
