We had a fair turn out for the Fifth Military Rifle Match with 9 shooters competing. We encourage more of our members to come out to learn and shoot. Dave White & his M1A took first place with a score of 258. Chris Sucoe took second place with his 03A3 & a score of 220, while Gerry Marken nailed down third with his Rock River AR-15 with a score of 205. Big Al Lamoreaux shot a 192 with his Garand, Greg Larson along with his son Dayne shot a 142 & 181 with their K98 Mauser. Nick Holt & his Swiss Schmidt-Rubin K31 had a score of 201 while Jeff Gage brought in a 63 with his K98 Mauser and Jay Pearson, a first time match shooter, shot his Garand for an 86. Next match will be in Sept 2007. We will begin the Sept. Match with an hour of instruction on the proper use of the sling, and a thorough demonstration of prone, sitting & standing/offhand positions. Otherwise the strings of fire will remain the same with 35 rounds being the max. 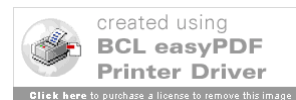
