Release, Waiver, Indemnification, Hold Harmless Assumption Of Risk Agreement (TCSL)

In consideration of being permitted to use firearms, for the use of the ranges, any buildings, or land (collectively described as Tri-County Sportsman League, TCSL) and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned MEMBER, SHOOTER (or guest) agrees to each of the following:

The MEMBER, SHOOTER (or guest) agrees to **indemnify, hold harmless and defend** Tri-County Sportsman League, it's Range Officers, Instructors and Board of Directors, from any and all fault, liabilities, costs, claims, demands, or lawsuits arising out of, related to, or connected with any of the following: the discharge of firearms by the guest; the guests presence on or use of the TCSL ranges and any and all acts or omissions of the member, shooter or guest.

Furthermore, the member, shooter or guest **waives** for himself/herself and for his/her personal representatives, assignees, next of kin and heirs, any rights and claims for damages, losses, demands, and any other actions or claims whatsoever, which he/she may have or which may arise against TCSL (including, but not limited to, the death of member, shooter or guest and/or any and all personal injury or illness, or other personal damages or property damages (of whatever nature) suffered by the member, shooter or guest or the member's, shooter's or guest's property), which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with use of the ranges.

The Range Officers/Board of Directors of TSCL shall not be liable for, and Member, Shooter or guest, on behalf of himself/herself and on behalf of his/her personal representatives, assignees, next of kin, and heirs, hereby **expressly releases**, the range officers/ BOD from any such claims and liabilities.

The member, shooter or guest hereby **expressly assumes** the risk of taking part in the use of the TCSL ranges, taking part in activities which may include (but not limited to) instruction in the use of firearms, the discharge of firearms and the firing of live ammunition.

The MEMBER, SHOOTER or GUEST hereby acknowledges and agrees that the MEMBER, SHOOTER or GUEST has **read this agreement, understands its terms and is executing this instrument voluntarily**. The member, shooter or guest furthermore hereby acknowledges and agrees that he/she has read, understands and will at all times abide by all range rules and procedures and any other rules and procedures stated by the range officers/BOD.

The MEMBER, SHOOTER or GUEST expressly agrees that this instrument is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law, and that if any provision of this agreement is held invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be impaired thereby. No remedy conferred by any of the specific provisions of this agreement is intended to be exclusive of any other remedy and each and every remedy shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy now or hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute or otherwise. The election of any one or more remedies by the range officers/BOD to enforce the RO's/BOD's right to pursue other available remedies. This agreement binds the member, shooter or guest and his/her personal representatives, assignees, next of kin and heirs.
