# Military Rifle Match 2017 Military Rifle Match Held

A winter Military Rifle match was held on Saturday March 18th at the 100-yard rifle range. We had 8 shooters, with firearms represented that included AR-15's, a CETME 308, M1903 Springfield, Lee Enfield No4 and an Arisaka Type 99. A Special Thanks to Gerry Marken and David Vandermark for their help with setting up the shoot.

Results of Saturdays Match: Winner of the match for the Scoped Division was David Harris with a 100-8X, Mike Johnston took 2nd place with a 96-2x and 3rd place was Jim Szocik with a 96-1X. Winner of the Iron Sight Division was Mark Smokowicz with a score of 97-3x, 2nd place was Gerry Marken with a score of 91-1x and 3rd place was Paul Siska with a score of 91. Congratulations to all shooters.

Our next Military Rifle Match will be held on Saturday, April 15th and is open to TCSL members and guests. Registration starts at 9am and the match begins at 10am. A short safety briefing will be held prior to the match. Fees for the match will be \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. You can compete with any military style rifle, foreign or domestic, modern or vintage, with iron sights or scope.

The April match begins our normal course of fire, which includes (5) rounds of slow fire in the prone position for sight-in within 5 minutes. For score: (10) rounds slow fire in the prone position, (10) rounds of rapid fire in the prone position, (10) rounds rapid fire in the sitting position and (10) round of slow fire in the standing unsupported position.

### Military Rifle Match con't

Slow fire portion are single fed fired within 10 minutes, and Rapid fire is within 80 seconds with a magazine or stripper clip change. Bring 45 rounds of safe ammunition, safety or shooting glasses, hearing protection, registration fee and appropriate clothing. A spotting scope, shooting mat and sling is useful.

An NRA Personal Protection In The Home class for women only that meets the training requirements for a Michigan Concealed Pistol License is being offered at Tri-County Sportsmen's League, Saline on Saturday, May 6, 2017 from 8:00am to about 6:00pm. Price for the CCW class is \$150. For TCSL members it is \$115.

You must be able to place most shots on an 8-1/2" x 11" blank sheet of paper at a distance of 21 feet. Bring a handgun, eye and ear protection, and 100 rounds of ammunition. A few .22 handguns are available for rent. Call to reserve one.

You may register for the class on-line by going to the link below and completing the form. Payment by cash or check is due before class begins. The classroom will be open about 7:30am.


