September President's Column

If you are the chair of a committee please make sure by October 19, 2017 to submit your 2018 projection / forecast of the out-of-pocket expenses for your committee that are anticipated in 2018. This is not an approval of any formal budget, it is to help the Board make decisions as the year progresses with an understanding of what expenses are expected in 2018. Your projection / forecast should also help you as you prepare the annual committee report to the Board to be given at the TCSL Board January 2018 meeting. Please drop a copy of your projection / forecast into Carlos Soto's, acting 1st Vice President's mailbox as well as my mailbox.

Al Lamoreaux, Membership Secretary, will be mailing out 2018 TCSL renewals in early December 2017. He needs to have all of the 2017 volunteer hours entered by November 30, 2017 so that his renewal forms are accurate. It is easier for Al if committee chairs/event chairs make sure all volunteer hours are given to Al each month so he doesn't have a long list given to enter all at once. Committee chairs please make sure all of your crews' volunteer hours are given to Al in September so he can enter them as soon as possible. Members should go on-line and check their volunteer hours for 2017 to see if you have been given credit for all of the hours you worked. If your hours are wrong, contact your committee chair or event chair and make sure Al has received a list of all volunteer hours worked.

As the year winds down, it is the time when nominations for a seat on the TCSL Board or a TCSL Officer seat will soon be accepted. If you are currently sitting on the TCSL Board, then at the December 2017 Board Meeting you will need to announce your decision to run for an officer position. Article 3 Section 9 of the TCSL Bylaws states:

"Any Director who shall elect to run for an office or any Director who cannot remain seated for their full term shall resign their Directorship at the December Board of Directors meeting effective the end of the membership year."

If you decide to run for an officer position, you will still sit on the Board until February 28, 2018, then your term will end and if elected you will take over as an officer at the TCSL March 2018 Board meeting.

There will be TCSL officer seats that are open as well as TCSL Board seats at the February 2018 election. If you want to have a voice in the direction TCSL takes then throw your hat into the ring. Serving as an officer or board member is a rewarding experience. It is also a great way to earn volunteer hours and to keep up-to-date on the events at TCSL.

October 2017 will be a Membership Drive Month. Please take some extra time to bring potential members to TCLS and show them around during October 2017. The member who brings in the most new members in October 2017 will receive one free dinner at each of the TCSL Friday Steak Fry dinners in 2018. Remember there are no monthly Steak Fry Dinners in November and December each year due to the holidays.

A Military Rifle Match was held on Saturday August 19th on the 100-yd rifle range. Rifles represented included AR-15s, M1 Garands, M14 and an M1A.

Results of the match: 1st Place with a sore of 363 out of 400 was David Harris, 2nd place went to Gerry Marken with a score of 325 and in 3rd place was Rob Ashley with a score of 299.

The next Military Rifle Match will be held on <u>Saturday September 16th, 2017</u>. Registration begins at 9:00 am and the match starts at 10:00am. The match is open to members \$10 and guests \$15. To compete all you need is a military style rifle (non-automatic), domestic or foreign, vintage or modern, sporterized or customized, scoped or iron sights. You will need 45 rounds of safe ammunition, a shooting mat or something to lie on, safety or shooting glasses and ear protection. Spotting scopes and sling are helpful.

The course of fire for the event shall be: (5) rounds of slow fire in the prone positon for sight-in within 5 minutes. For score; (10) rounds slow fire in the prone position, (10) rounds of rapid fire in the prone position, (10) rounds rapid fire in the sitting position and (10) rounds of slow fire in the standing unsupported position. For the Slow fire portion single fed rounds are fired within 10 minutes, while Rapid fire is within 80 seconds with a magazine or stripper clip change. The next IDPA match will be September 23, 2017. New shooters and spectators are always welcome! Bring a handgun suitable for self defense, 150 rounds of ammunition, a belt-mounted holster that covers the trigger guard, concealment garment, and at least 3 magazines to join the fun.
