



At Signal:	Draw & engage T1 & T2 on the move to P2. At P2 engage T3-T6 tactical priority. Move to P3 and engage popper first and T7 & T8 in any priority					
**Notes:	**Notes: Shooter may re-engage T1 & T2 at P2. tactical priority T3-T6 can be re-engaged at P3 as long as they have been fully engaged at P2. 180 degree Muzzle Safe Plane rule in effect.



Style:	Freestyle	Reload:	IDPA Approved	Min. Rounds:	17	
Start:	Standing at P1 hands relaxed at sides.					
At Signal:	Shooter begins and remains at P1 facing downrange. Upon signal, draw and engage T2-T5 in tactical priority with 2 rounds each. T1 must be engaged with 2 rounds before and after engaging each other target. Targets in the same plane (T2/T3 and T4/T5) are equivalent threats.					
**Notes:	180 degree muzzle safe point

At Signal:	Engage T1 with 2 shots while standing at P1 At P2 engage T2 – T3 with 2 shots each in tactical priority At P3 engage Mini Popper then T4 – T5 with 2 shots each in tactical priority At P4 engage T6 – T8 with 2 shots each in tactical priority					
**Notes:	180 degree muzzle safe point Steel must fall to score




Tri-County Sportsman's League IDPA Scenario July 2014



"Shopping Mall"



Start:	Standing at P1 (behind wall) hands relaxed at sides					
At Signal:	Signal: At the signal, draw and engage T1-T2 and PP1 from cover (behind and over top of wall), in any order. From P2 and P3 engage T3-T8 using the walls as cover, in tactical priority.					
**Notes:	Shooter may go to P2 or P3 in any order. 180 degree muzzle safe plane rule in effect.

Start:	Standing at P1, pistol holstered and loaded to division capacity, activator line in strong hand				
At Signal:	Pull activator line with strong hand to activate swinger While retreating, draw and engage T1-T2 with two shots each in tactical sequence Proceed to either P2 and engage T3 – T8 in tactical priority. You may go either right or left but must engage all targets on both sides to complete the COF> Shoot through T4 to activate DT5.				
**Notes:	180 degree muzzle rule is in effect
